## Do you want to be a better leader?

A professional learning programme for leaders and aspirant leaders in the area of Languages Education. We strongly encourage language teachers in primary schools to apply.

Essentially the course is designed to encourage professional growth at departmental and school levels. Teachers will be involved in an action learning cycle that focuses on curriculum leadership and managing change (including confronting and managing power relationships in schools), the development of successful sustainable language programmes within schools, and on mentoring in languages education.

The programme involves a series of five full day workshops spread across the academic year, together with action learning and planning within a whole school context.

Teachers will also be involved in an online unit (FLOTE) which can allow for accreditation towards a Masters Degree at Murdoch University.
