Communicating Effectively with Emotional Intelligence

This is a cross sectoral opportunity for Department of Education, Catholic and AISWA aspiring or existing school leaders.

Contemporary research will be utilised to provide each participant with the understanding of what emotional intelligence is and how it impacts in leadership contexts.

Through completion of this one day, cross sectoral course participants will:

- ✓ Understand the what, and why of EQ – what does get results?

- ✓ Identify the personal habits that need to be considered and addressed, to ensure they “transform good intentions into great results.”
