



EDUCATION POLICY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE

Nominations are currently being sought for **two Educators** to join the AISWA Education Policy Consultative Committee.

The Education Policy Consultative Committee consists of up to eight members including the Chair of the Education Policy Consultative Committee (who is a Principal and also a member of the Board of AISWA) and up to six elected members, all of whom are educators. Each Committee Member is elected for a three year term.

The role of the Education Policy Consultative Committee is to:

- Contribute to the consultative processes for the formulation of education policy
- Provide advice to the Board of AISWA on appropriate responses to education policy decisions made by State and Federal Government.
- Provide advice to members on the impact of educational decisions made by the State and Federal Government.

MEETINGS

The Education Policy Consultative Committee has one scheduled meeting per year and additional meetings may be scheduled on an as-needed basis.

Meetings are held in the AISWA Boardroom, 3/41 Walters Drive, Osborne Park, commencing at 12.30 pm (*lunch is provided*). Meetings are generally no more than 1.5 hours in duration.
