**Where:** The school is located in a bushland setting in the southern suburbs of Perth, Australia (approx. 20 minutes from the CBD). Nearby is the popular and cosmopolitan town of Fremantle and the school is only 15 minutes from the coast. We provide a full Steiner curriculum from Playgroup to Class 12.

**Who:** We are seeking an enthusiastic teacher to join our wonderful team of teachers and commence with our High School students in July 2018. New graduates with the right passion to learn and some life experience are welcome to apply.

The successful applicant will have a passion for education, appropriate qualifications to teach English and have a willingness to adopt the Steiner pedagogy and philosophy. At present a position with a 0.7 full time equivalent is available, however there is the possibility of increasing the FTE depending on the ability to teach in other learning areas.
