

Primary Teacher

We require an experienced Primary Teacher who is creative, passionate, nurturing and committed to delivering a stimulating and creative program for primary aged students.

The Role

We will require you to work as a Primary teacher of a mixed aged class of Yr 1 & 2. (15 students) There is a potential for this position to become permanent after successful completion of probation.

The position begins on 14th April, 2025 as a 2 week led up to the beginning of term 2 on 28th April, 2025.

- A vast experience across Early Childhood and Primary school environments with multi aged learning.
- Confidence in delivering our Education Program and dedicated to our Mode of Delivery.
- Willingness to work towards our Mission and Goals for best practice.
- Work collaboratively with fellow staff members, the School Board and the Parents.
- Strong written communication
- Highly developed interpersonal skills
- Ability to work within a team
- Self-motivated and autonomous
- Organized, reliable with the ability to meet deadlines.
- Demonstrate integrity and absolute discretion when dealing with confidential information
- Available to undertake training or meetings outside of normal work hours.

- Current Teacher Registration (Act 2012)
- Current Working with Children (Criminal Record Checking) Act 2004(Criminal Record Checking) Regulations 2005.
- Recent (within last 12 months) Professional development in Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse training.

Music & Movement lessons are delivered in an open studio space where the children have the ability to

move and create freely. Art sessions are delivered in an open studio or outside to capture the natural surroundings.

We aim to provide a natural environment that calms the mind and provides the students with many openended opportunities for learning experiences that align with the Western Australian Curriculum.

We believe this develops an appreciation and understanding of nature, respect for the environment, sense of belonging and self-discovery.





Educational Program

Our Integrated Educational Program we accommodate the educational needs and diversity of students fostering lifelong learning skills and freedom to explore their strengths and interests.

We aim to deliver programs that encourages cooperative and collaborative learning.

Our school and class environment support intellectual, social and physical learning processes and recognise that the child is at the centre of the program.

We aim for our programs to meet the learning needs of all students as we implement the Western Australian Curriculum and Assessment Outline.

Music & Movement Education and an Environmental Education Program will be an important part of our school's program. Visual Arts, Language and Physical Education will also be prominent.

Our Music & Movement program is based on Carl Orff's approach – Orff Schulwerk. The Orff Schulwerk Pedagogy along with music and movement has strong links with many other learning areas.
